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## WORKSHOP

In this workshop the attendees will design and make a 30" x 30" quilt top, learning different techniques to piece curves and concentric circles. During the class we will explore different compositions, color combinations and shapes. The attendees will learn how to cut fabrics with complex shapes and how to sew these curved shapes by machine.

## **MATERIALS NEEDED**


- 35" x 35" piece of fabric (it will be your background)
- Hue A: Four different values, 1FQ per value
- Hue B: Four different values, 1FQ per value
- · For the class prepare all your fabrics, ironing them with your preferred fabric starch
- · Small scissors with a sharp point
- Glue baste it, ROXANNE, temporary basting glue (with applicator) https://a.co/d/8fZRMlu
- Pins
- Fabric marker (erasable)
- Rotary cutter (IMPORTANT=> with a new blade)
- · Quilting ruler
- · Quarter inch foot and zipper foot
- · Thread for sewing
- · Sewing machine
- · Iron and ironing table
- · Notebook and pencil for taking notes
- Starch
